Cyprus International University provides a free shuttle service for its students and employees to support public transport and reduce carbon emissions. In 2022, 21,999 bus departures from the campus site were recorded (see table below). In 2021, the total number of departures recorded was 10,053. This represents an increase of 118 percent (undoubtedly, vaccination programs and the number of COVID-19 cases impacted this change to some extent). For 2023, increasing the number of departures is targeted as an ongoing process for sustainable commuting of students and staff.

Another target the university has is to sell at most the same amount of Parking Stamps (see the table for the number of parking places and the number of parking stamps sold). The university encourages public transportation by increasing the number of shuttle departures (free service).
