# **Cyprus International University Disposables Policy**

# Purpose

This policy outlines Cyprus International University's (CIU) commitment to minimizing the use of disposable (single-use) items on campus. It aims to reduce waste, promote sustainable practices, and encourage a culture of responsibility among students, faculty, and staff.

### Scope

This policy applies to all departments, students, faculty, staff, and visitors of Cyprus International University.

# **Policy Statement**

Cyprus International University is dedicated to reducing the environmental impact associated with disposable items. We recognize the need to shift towards more sustainable practices by minimizing the use of single-use products and encouraging the adoption of reusable alternatives.

# **Objectives**

- 1. **Reduce Single-Use Item Consumption**: Significantly decrease the use of disposable items on campus.
- 2. **Promote Reusable Alternatives**: Encourage reusable products such as containers, utensils, and bags.
- 3. **Increase Awareness and Education**: Raise awareness about the environmental impact of disposable items and promote sustainable practices within the university community.
- 4. **Engage Stakeholders**: Involve students, faculty, staff, and suppliers to minimize singleuse item consumption.

# **Strategies for Implementation**

#### **1.** Assessment of Single-Use Item Use

• Conduct an inventory of current disposable items used across campus to identify critical areas for reduction and target specific items.

#### 2. Elimination of Single-Use Items

- **Beverage Containers**: Phase out the sale and distribution of single-use plastic bottles on campus. Promote refillable water stations and provide incentives for using reusable water bottles.
- **Dining Services**: Encourage dining services to eliminate single-use cutlery, plates, and cups in favor of reusable options. Where necessary, explore compostable or biodegradable materials as alternatives.
- **Events and Activities**: Implement guidelines for all campus events prohibiting single-use items and encouraging reusable or compostable alternatives.

#### **3. Promotion of Reusable Alternatives**

- **Reusables Program**: Establish a program that provides students and staff with reusable bags, containers, and utensils and offers options for purchasing or borrowing items.
- **Campus Retailers**: Work with campus retailers to offer discounts for students and staff who bring their reusable containers or bags.

#### 4. Education and Awareness Campaigns

- Workshops and Seminars: Organize educational events that inform the university community about the environmental impacts of disposable items and the benefits of using reusables.
- **Marketing Materials**: Develop and distribute materials (posters, flyers, digital content) promoting the importance of minimizing disposable items and showcasing alternative practices.

#### 5. Collaboration with Stakeholders

- **Supplier Engagement**: Collaborate with suppliers to reduce packaging waste and identify sustainable product alternatives.
- **Student Involvement**: Encourage student organizations to participate in initiatives to reduce the consumption of disposable items, fostering a sense of ownership within the community.

#### 6. Monitoring and Reporting

- **Track Progress**: Regularly assess the effectiveness of efforts to minimize disposable items using surveys and feedback from the campus community.
- **Annual Review**: Conduct an annual review of this policy to evaluate its impact and identify areas for improvement.

# Responsibilities

- **Sustainability Committee**: This committee will oversee the implementation of this policy, monitor progress, and coordinate education and awareness initiatives.
- All Employees and Students: Expected to actively participate in minimizing disposable item use and promoting sustainable practices on campus.
- University Management: Provide support and resources for implementing this policy and promote a culture of sustainability.
