Cyprus International University Plastic Reduction Policy

Purpose

This plastic Reduction Policy outlines Cyprus International University's (CIU) commitment to minimizing plastic use on campus. This policy aims to reduce the environmental impact of plastic waste, promote sustainability, and encourage a culture of responsibility among students, faculty, and staff.

Scope

This policy applies to all departments, students, faculty, staff, and visitors of Cyprus International University.

Policy Statement

Cyprus International University is dedicated to reducing plastic waste and promoting sustainable practices. We recognize the environmental challenges of plastic pollution and are committed to implementing strategies that minimize plastic use, promote alternative materials, and encourage responsible consumption.

Objectives

- 1. **Reduce Single-Use Plastics**: Eliminate or significantly reduce the use of single-use plastic items across campus.
- 2. **Promote Reusable Alternatives**: Encourage reusable products and materials, such as water bottles, bags, and containers.
- 3. **Increase Awareness and Education**: Raise awareness about the impact of plastic pollution and promote sustainable practices among the university community.
- 4. **Engage Stakeholders**: Involve students, faculty, staff, and suppliers in efforts to reduce plastic use and promote sustainability.

Strategies for Implementation

1. Assessment of Plastic Use

• Conduct an inventory of current plastic use across campus to identify critical areas for reduction and target specific items.

2. Elimination of Single-Use Plastics

- **Beverage Containers**: Phase out single-use plastic beverage containers in campus facilities and events. Promote the use of refillable water stations and provide incentives for using reusable bottles.
