



CIU-NET ACCOUNT

Once your registration at CIU is completed, a CIU-NET student account will automatically be created for you. With your CIU-NET account, you can access Webmail, the Student Information System (SIS), CIU Mobile, and Moodle services. To create your password for the first time, click on the "New Student" button on the SIS homepage and follow the instructions provided. If you forget your password, you can reset it by clicking on the "Forgot Password" option.

WEBMAIL

Webmail is the official e-mail service provided to students by the University. You can access it from any device with an internet connection, such as a computer, tablet, or mobile phone. Through Webmail, you can send and receive e-mails as well as share files and documents.

STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (SIS)

SIS is a web-based platform that supports students throughout their academic journey. It simplifies academic and administrative processes, providing a seamless and user-friendly experience.

Through SIS, you can:

- Directly communicate with your advisor, book appointments, and follow up on your advising process online,
- Register for your courses interactively and view your weekly course schedule with real-time updates,
- Track your grades, transcript, curriculum, and academic progress in detail,
- · Follow university-wide announcements, news, and events,
- · View your payment plan and securely complete your online payments,
- Access online services and request modules offered by different university units to directly submit your needs.

SIS is not only a system that simplifies your transactions but also a dynamic platform that increases your engagement in university life and integrates you into CIU's Digital Campus vision.

CIU MOBILE

CIU Mobile is the official mobile application that allows students to stay connected with the University anytime, anywhere. Thanks to its SIS integration, CIU Mobile instantly notifies you about many important updates, such as exam results, new messages, petition responses, or exam location announcements. Students do not enroll themselves in courses; your courses are automatically transferred to Moodle based on the information in SIS. You can log in to Moodle using your CIU-NET account.
